Are you a physician and eager to become a translational scientist in the field of cardiovascular research? Then you might be interested in joining the **Physician Scientist Program of the Helmholtz-Institute for Translational AngioCardioScience (PS-HI-TAC)**. Physicians who have just graduated from medical school in Germany or abroad or are within the first three years of their medical training and can provide proof of basic scientific experience via an MD thesis or equivalent are eligible. Physician scientists - medical doctors involved both in patient care and research projects – are needed at the interface between bench and bedside. They promote the translation of basic scientific results into clinical application. For young and ambitious physicians, who strive for both a clinical and a scientific career, the PS-HI-TAC facilitates two years of scientific work in translational cardiovascular research. Mentoring will be provided by an established cardiovascular scientist at Heidelberg University or the Max Delbrück Center, Berlin. Thereafter, further clinical training until board specialization will be secured through a position at the University Hospitals of Heidelberg University, either in Heidelberg or Mannheim, and clinical mentors.



PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- Protected research time at Heidelberg University or Max Delbrück Center (2 years)
- Secured clinical training at University Hospitals of Heidelberg University (in Mannheim or Heidelberg)
- Scientific and clinical mentoring
- Accompanying scientific education at the School of Translational AngioCardioScience and other local programs
- Exposure to the scientific environment at the Helmholtz-Institute for Translational AngioCardioScience

4. targeted clinical and scientific institution with acceptance letter of each chair
